

Sermon Review

Violinist:

Greetings this Sunday morning and a brief explanation to everyone about this section. You'll find the "Sermon Review" in the bulletin on most Sundays to briefly review what was said the previous week. There are a variety of reasons for this inclusion but the main one is to briefly review the main point of the past week's message. There you go and here's some thoughts about last week's message.

When the John 21 text is considered, Peter is often condemned or scolded for his sin even more so than what we can tell from how Jesus addressed the situation. Saying that "we love Jesus" does not mean we will always completely follow his lead and commands perfectly. Did Peter's failure mean he was a complete failure and hypocrite and completely uncommitted to Christ? Of course not. What happened is that when Peter faced a new level of trial and tribulation and cost to discipleship he was not prepared to endure that event, and so consequently he failed the Lord miserably. Jesus knew this would happen and Jesus was willing to restore Peter.

Have you been there before in your walk with Christ? You will be if you have not been, and if you have never been in that pressing situation of being squeezed by life's challenges that is most unusual and not normal. So, welcome to the rest of your life in following Christ. Where he leads us individually and collectively is both wonderful and costly. Remember this as we journey on with Jesus. 
