

#### Sermon Review

Good morning and welcome to our Worship Experience for July 28<sup>th</sup>. Did you have breakfast with us this morning? It sure was delicious and I'm grateful for those who prepared it. Please join us the last Sunday of each month at 9 a.m. if you are not in the habit of being there.

Our topic last Sunday was "When You Meet GOD". Our texts were Genesis 15, 26 & 28. GOD loves us so much HIS love can reach us wherever we are at, and then HIS love will bring us to where

GOD is at not leaving us the way GOD found us. Are these truths part of your journey when "you met GOD"?


