

Good Morning and welcome to our Worship Experience for August 4th! Are you going to have lunch with the Lunch Bunch? We do this every first Sunday of the month after worship. Trust you will make it a part of your planning in the future if not today.

Our topic last Sunday was "When You Meet JESUS CHRIST". Our text came from John's gospel in several references to the purpose and identity of who JESUS CHRIST is and what He came to earth to do. JESUS is the one person most significant ever in human history. We have so often heard the description of JESUS being the Son of GOD that it has somewhat lost its sacred meaning. He is not only the Son of GOD but when you genuinely encounter the Living Son of the Living GOD it is not an experience that you walk away from without it incredibly impacting the depth of your being. John referred to the fact that we have "seen His glory". What this phrase partially means is that it's John's way of attempting to say to his readers, "Hey, when you meet JESUS, you not only meet Him but you are taken into a small realm of encountering the Living GOD. Describing the experience of meeting JESUS is a challenge to the human being. None of us can completely and adequately describe the fullness of who JESUS is. It's as if He is so wonderful that every time you meet with the LORD He will always reveal more of His purpose, character, heart, and ability to you. Some persons hurt their own faith journey by presuming that once they have encountered CHRIST there is no more of HIS glory to ever more deeply know. Nothing could be further from the truth. When we meet JESUS, HE opens up the glorious privilege of having access to the wonders of knowing our Heavenly Father. This is an ever continuous process. Every opportunity to commune with CHRIST just takes us further into HIS heart, grace and love and plan for us! In conclusion, when you meet JESUS CHRIST, if you are open to HIS truth, you are always left with a desire to know and evidence more of HIS love and light for you and others. JESUS is the only person in human history you could say, "we have met one another but yet I kept on encountering new wonders of HIS love for me as we continue to walk together. 
