These gifts manifest themselves all the more as we remember, learn and request the HOLY SPIRIT to reveal further the supremacy of our LORD over all forms of brokenness in our lives. The HOLY SPIRIT longs for us to learn even more deeply that communion is a time for celebration as we walk further into the light of CHRIST. Can your heart hear HOLY SPIRIT telling you, "come to supper", JESUS is waiting for you?
