Good morning to you, Sons and Daughters of the Living GOD!!! May the LORD bless you today as you have come to worship JESUS and we trust further encounter HIS amazing grace!!! In last week's message I put in front of you some basic challenges about financial stewardship. Although money is not the only part of stewardship it is a major part of our life and steward service to the LORD. So, we must give consideration to what part of our income and wealth we will give to the LORD's work and ministry? That being said, we must learn the LORD will give us the initiative and the grace to learn how to give as the LORD would have us give. This is one of the major theme's in the story told in Genesis 22 about how GOD directed Abraham to go and sacrifice his son Isaac to the Lord. Now it seems, in our culture, archaic, barbaric and preposterous that GOD would direct anyone to give up their child on an altar of sacrifice. If you respond to the story with those feelings it is understandable, but it misses the point of where the LORD is taking Abraham. GOD is after Abraham learning to totally trust the LORD in all of Abraham's life decisions. GOD makes it know to Abraham that 'I am Jehovah Jireh, the LORD who provides'. Even after the LORD makes this known to Abraham, the sacrifice is still appropriate, it just happens to be a ram instead of a son. But consider this! GOD did sacrifice His own son to redeem us. In Christ, GOD gave up everything to redeem us back to himself. So, if GOD is so willing to give so much to us, whatever we could or should give back to GOD is not quite the same level of giving. The direction to give may really challenge us but the direction to give is not unfair on GOD's part to request. Giving teaches us to think like CHRIST and by the HOLY SPIRIT's work, giving transforms our character into what pleases the LORD!!! The next time you are possibly challenged by the notion of giving, just remember the LORD always practices what He preaches to us. GOD gave so much and still does. May the LORD have mercy on us all as we practice giving in stewardship ourselves. Blessings for the journey! Pastor Robert


