What a blessing last Sunday's worship service was with the baptism of Kinsley Elizabeth Howard! We hate it for you if you were not here to be reminded, challenged, convicted and directed further into Christ's call on your life as we celebrated GOD's baptism of Kinsley. I intend to use some Sunday morning material on baptism and what it points to into the next calendar year. In last Sunday's message we spent time considering what Kinsley's baptism should mean to us and we asked some questions about Mark's gospel and what contribution it makes to the Christmas story and how does all this relate to one another. Wow, that was a task. It would be a challenge to put that down on paper in a brief paragraph statement. So this review really does not do the worship experience much justice but here are a few points to ponder. Every human being born has a destiny greater than normally realized. Christmas is not just celebrating Christ being born. It is the celebration of His birth and the beginning of Jesus' conquest of His destiny. In baptism we are celebrating both the birth of a child and the truth that GOD in CHRIST invites that child to a destiny beyond anyone's imagination. Using a play on words we were reminded Christmas is not about making straight A's. Avoid the pitfalls of "all about us", "anything goes", "ask & you should get it" and "atheist attitudes" regarding Christmas. Then avoid the terrible B's of Christmas, "behaving good 2 be rewarded", "be nice b/c it's Christmas", "born w/out destiny", "be busy in the hustle and bustle of the tussle of the holidays" and "buy it no matter what and pay for it forever". Those A's & B's should be avoided every Christmas season. Instead make C's at Christmas. C Christ in Christmas! C the Christian journey in Christmas! That's what baptism is primarily about. C the children's innocence in Christmas! C the celebration of Christmas! C charity in Christmas! And most of all C the purpose of a child in Christmas! It starts with seeing Christ's purpose in Christmas in His childhood and then realizing that we too in the FATHER's sight are to Him a child. What is our purpose in His sight? Only you can answer that for your life. Are you seeking out what that purpose is? It's very important to JESUS for our discovering what that is. It is so important to JESUS that He goes as far as saying that if we do His will in our lives then we are just like his mother and brothers to Him. At first glance that statement of CHRIST may sound a bit too generous, maybe even an exaggeration but to JESUS when we discover our purpose and walk in the will of GOD we ARE as if we ARE the immediate family of JESUS. That's how much we mean to JESUS! It's part of the baptism message. Are we further discovering this incredible truth? Blessings for the journey! Pastor Robert
