Sermon Review

Praise the LORD!!! I trust that all of us have seen the faithfulness of GOD this week? It's always there! Sometimes we are looking and other times we aren't. How is your purpose in CHRIST doing? There are weeks our greatest purpose goes unchallenged it seems and then sometimes the entire world seems like it is shaking around us and in us! Did you feel the earthquake a week ago? We didn't but it still happened whether we were aware of it or not. Life is often like that! Things are going on all around us whether we are attentive or not. When it comes to purpose there are allies and enemies to our greatest goals in life. We discussed a few of those last week. Of course the greater the purpose one holds in life the greater resistance works against their life regarding that purpose. But be assured! The LORD also has allies to join you in your conquest to live life at a maximum purpose. Let's assume your purpose is above and beyond the trivial matters and issues of life that human beings can fall prey to being too concerned about. Examples are excessive comforts, more money than really needed, success in men's eyes, etc. Those purposes don't last even if we obtain them. The allies and enemies list we covered last Sunday are there to assist or stop great purposes and purposes the LORD would give GOD's children. To review, the enemies of purpose are many but three of the common obstacles to purpose are false purposes, unresolved disappointments and all past experiences and circles of influence from persons who do not share or understand your purpose. If you want more information about these three, ask me. The allies to purpose are gifts from GOD that will help you stay on track no matter what is happening in your life. Your allies to purpose are forgive and forget and forget and forgive, count your experiences correctly, renew your spirit in GOD's continued grace and always keep in your focus that your life is eternal not temporary! Again, if you want more information about these four, ask me.
