

### Sermon Review

Good Morning brothers and sisters in CHRIST!!! Today's notes are strictly a review of last week's message as I'm not speaking this morning. Give your attention to Tom Geddens as he delivers the WORD today, and thank you Tom for doing just that. May the LORD find deep space in our hearts to receive and hide HIS WORD in our lives for HIS purpose. In last week's message we gave attention to Father's Day, of course, being that it was Father's Day. The primary point in the message was to describe that dads should be patterned after the original dad who is GOD almighty, the great I AM who revealed HIS character within our character traits in HIS original order and creation. Unfortunately, sin really badly messed that up and too many of us dads are not learning to walk with our Heavenly Father as well as we can through faith in CHRIST. Our behavior and intentions should be patterned after the original dad, GOD!!!! We have witnessed Fatherhood, fatherhoax and fatherghost in our society. All absentee fathers are not equally guilty of desertion of their children but no matter why they left, and even if it was not their intent to leave their children, when fathers are absent in their children's lives it often leads to damaged children. This is the fatherghost syndrome. The dad was there. Now he's gone! Then we have fatherhoax. This parenting skill is often seen in dads who can provide material possessions but not love, leadership and character. They mean well but good intentions do not necessarily create well rounded emotionally healthy children. When dads provide without known, spoken, demonstrated love and character development and leadership then the provision just becomes stuff. How many children have all the stuff but little love? This is so sad when it is evidenced in a child's life. Their pockets and hands are full but their hearts are empty. But thanks be to GOD we have dad's who practice FATHERHOOD! This is the original plan of our Heavenly Father. Our GOD wanted men to model fatherhood to their children. GOD wanted dads who spent time with their children teaching them the how to's of life and the pleasures of life be it sports, cooking, building or whatever. Children need their dad to be their coach, their friend when possible, their protector, their moral compass and their authority who knows how to say no even when the child reacts negatively to the word no. Most of all, children need to see love in their dads. One of the lies that dads buy into is that the job of being dad ends when your children become young adults. Oh, this is not true! If you are a parent you will be a parent until you leave this world. Being a dad is one of the highest calls and opportunities to serve CHRIST! You are molding tomorrow's society and GOD is your primary help and model. So dads, the LORD's grace and strength to us all!!!
