Welcome to our second Sunday of emphasis on stewardship in our faith journey. In last week's celebration of the LORD's Supper we gave attention to the presence of JESUS among us. It is very interesting that when the LORD JESUS was physically present with the disciples they were unaware of HIS presence with them. When they realized that it was HE, the CHRIST, he disappeared from their physical sight! He was more present with them even in HIS physical disappearance after they realized He was there! This is a strange paradox but it brings to our attention a great truth about our presence in church. Is it strong enough when we are there that persons sense our "disappearance" when we are not there? In the body of Christ we are to be present at all times. I have known persons affiliated with a local church that when they were not present you did not know it and when they were present you did not know it. What makes us present or not is not how often we are at the local church events but whether our spirit is involved in the process or not. Some of you may be thinking, what does this have to do with stewardship. A LOT !!!! We cannot claim to have a commitment to some value that we have no commitment to ever be there in any possible fashion. If we want the presence of GOD in our local church two things must happen. One, we must believe and look for HIS presence to be there based upon HIS character and reasons to be with us. Two, we must surrender our will to be in control to HIS spirit. When we talk about being present with the local church we don't just mean being present in the local church. We also mean being surrendered to HIS presence in the local church. So therefore, when we add our presence to HIS presence then a wonderful thing happens. People see us but they experience HIM, the LORD JESUS CHRIST!!!! That's what we should all want in our local church. Blessings for the journey! Pastor Robert Reeves
