If you were here last week you know our focus on Christian Stewardship was prayer. I appreciated what was said about prayer from those who took part in the service last week. Possibly, you are thinking to yourself, "what does prayer have to do with stewardship?" or "what does prayer have to do with our giving money to ministry?". These are noteworthy questions and if you have not worked out at least a basic concept of how prayer and stewardship work together then consideration to these questions are worth your investment of time and study. It has been said before that a person's money is the last thing they will give a church and the first thing they will take back. This may be true for some persons and if it is true, it is true because that's how much their money may mean to them. They put great value on their dollars. It represents power to them and represents a way to make their voice be heard to the positive or the negative. I approve so I give. I disapprove so I don't give. Really? Although every one of us will approve or disapprove of virtually everything we encounter in life, our stewardship should never be based upon our approval or disapproval. Financial stewardship is based upon one main issue. Our love of GOD and our commitment to HIS purpose no matter what. Now how does this relate to prayer? Unfortunately, for any person who doesn't see the truth to place CHRIST first in all forms of life's stewardship, such persons probably would not even think of prayer as being that important to them, particularly if they are a self made, self driven or self controlled human being. While it has been said that money is the last thing some persons will give the church and the first thing they will take back, if we are walking with the LORD as we can then prayer would be the first thing we give the LORD and the last thing we would never take back from HIM. Somewhere in that process our money is in the equation. Prayer is first, money is down the line in order of significance, but if prayer is first then money will certainly be included in our process of stewardship. Another way to say this is the following. If I'm going to give myself to prayer as I am called to and have opportunity to be involved in, then my giving of finances will also be a part of my Christian Stewardship discipline. A person who is out of balance about prayer could be out of balance about financial giving. A person in balance about prayer will probably be in balance about their financial giving. Just some thoughts to ponder. Blessings for the journey!!! Pastor Robert
