Over the Advent season we have looked at three "got-2-have-em" Christmas gifts we cannot fully live without. The truth is we need them year round. If you can remember 3 major letters in the sequence of the alphabet or if you have watched the "Wheel of Fortune" show more than twice, you know R, S & T are very important letters. They represent repentance, salvation and thorough, total or timely surrender. Surrender is tough! Our old carnal nature fights it constantly. It does not want to die, give up, take second, listen, admit it is wrong or submit at all to JESUS! Our only chance to give ourselves to JESUS in the gift of surrender is to remember the gifts of repentance and salvation are there to help us do it. Have you ever deeply wondered or studied the notion of JESUS teaching that we should "take up our cross and follow HIM?" What does this basically mean? SURRENDER is what it means! This is a very scary word to any of us who have invested great time and energy assuring ourselves that we must be right and that if anything is wrong it is somebody else's fault. Some disciples don't go very far in experiencing the blessed truth that surrender is a victory not a defeat! How sad if we never come to this realization. The way forward into life and truth is to die to ourselves, not insistence on our way, rights and preferences. The bottom line is this..... If we attempt to save ourselves we will lose ourselves. If we risk losing ourselves we will find ourselves! Do you recognize that statement from someone we claim to believe in their philosophy of life principles? HE lived it and practiced it all the way to some place named Golgotha where it got him killed but then just like HE said it would happen, even death could not keep that man down.
