The time of JESUS' death drew near and he kept going because he understood the greater truths beyond what he was looking at in this temporary world. 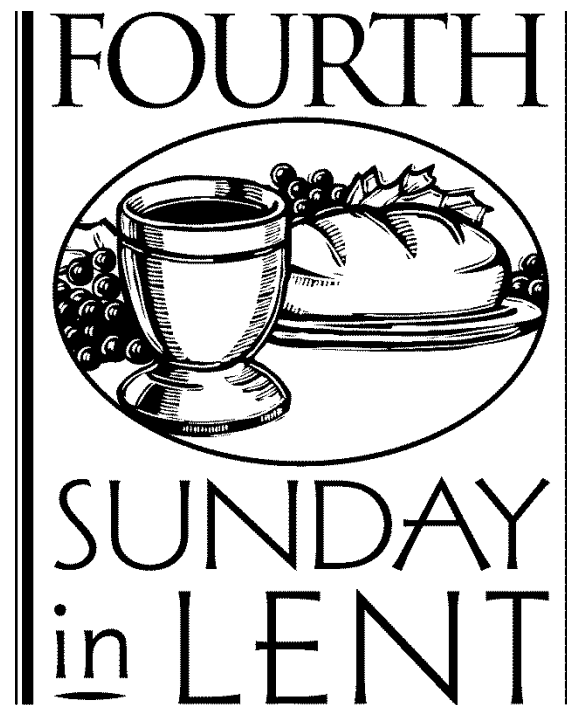

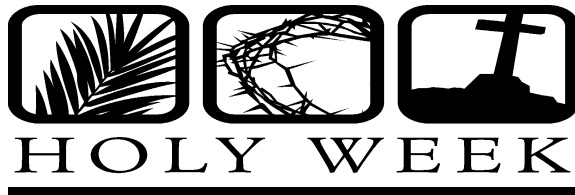

This event, led by Donna Muszynski, will provide a meal, palliative foot care, new socks and a Blessing Bag for Columbia's homeless. Last year, they washed the feet of 132 guests. This year, the goal is to serve over 200. Items needed for this ministry include new, fitted athletic socks (with a heel and toe, not tube socks), hotel size shampoo, conditioner, lotion, mouthwash, deodorant, chapstick, packs of tissues, bandaids, Q-tips, wet wipes, female sanitary items, packs of gum, granola bars, trail mix and a card or small token that says you care. You can also support them through gifts of money, which can be mailed to 2255 Sunset Boulevard, West Columbia or given through Trinity.

Those who want to participate must attend ONE of two training sessions, held at Trinity UMC Fellowship Hall. You can choose from either Thursday, March 26, from 6-8 p.m. or Saturday, March 28, from 9-11 a.m.
