The real story in most stories is not what we see or hear about, but the preliminaries behind what happened. That is the real story. We have heard the phrase or used it ourselves. What is the real story behind the story? We want to know not just what happened but why it happened, to whom and with whom and all the details. When you look at John 13 the most important verses are the first three. Yes, it is wonderful to think about JESUS serving us and the call and honor to serve one another, but exactly how could GOD almighty, besides becoming a man, decide to also so serve HIS disciples. HE, the KING, behaved as a slave in washing the disciples feet. Wow!!! How could JESUS so serve HIS creation? Because of the story behind the story that is referred to in the first 3 verses. In those verses we learn two things. We see what from Heaven was going on and what from Hell was going on! Unfortunately, we are too familiar with the abused, misused and overused phrase, "what in the Hell is going on?" Of course that comment is often used the most when we are interested in the least about what really is happening in Hell. Have you ever heard someone say, "What in the Heaven is going on?" not to dress up what has become profanity but to use this exclamation about something good going on? If someone shares super good news with you this week, say to them in response, "Well what in the Heaven is going on!" and don't laugh at the look you'll probably receive from them. But the question is very important. What from Heaven is really going on around us? The text tells us that JESUS knew Heaven was in control, not Hell. JESUS knew where he had come from, where he was going and what was happening around Him. He also knew what from Hell was going on too. The Devil had prompted Judas to betray JESUS and so he did but JESUS ALREADY KNEW IT WAS GOING TO HAPPEN!!!! The Devil was fooled, not JESUS! JESUS knew what was going on in Heaven and in Hell and so HE maintained control of HIS actions through it all the week of HIS passion. Thank you JESUS for how you kept it together when the situation looked really bad. But JESUS knew the story behind the story and that is what most counts in every story. Are you asking the LORD to give you HIS insight to your life story? He'll do it if you desire to find out what is really happening around you, in you, to you & for you. JUST ASK HIM!!! 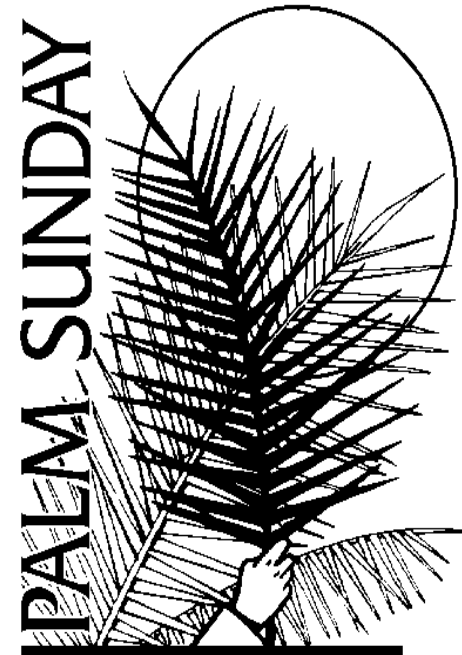

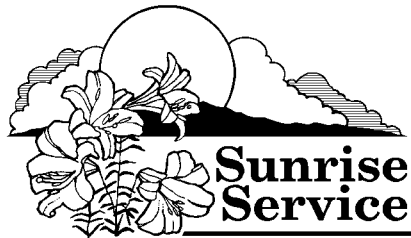
