This morning we again visit the subject matter “There is more to the RESURRECTION than just Easter!” I've got some bad news and some good news. The bad news is that we can all have the terrible let down of the "Judas Factor" present in our life. I'll explain that in the message. The good news - no, it's better than good, it's great and wonderful news - is that no matter what your "Judas Factor" is, the RESURRECTION IS BIGGER THAN those "Judas Factors"! Let's look at these truths this morning. Can't wait to celebrate JESUS!!!!
