Last week we gave our attention to the parable of the 10 virgins. Only so much can be said in 15 minutes about a parable that reflects 2000 plus years of church history. That said, the parable is applicable to every generation and time of church history. From this parable we are challenged to ask ourselves, "are we ready" for whatever the LORD is up to or knows is coming our way? Secondly, are we alert to the season we are in? While something may not be happening now, are we getting ready for that upcoming season? By the question about alertness, we also mean are we not spiritually sleeping, unaware of what opportunities we have ahead of us and what lurks around us attempting to pull us away from a place of sensitivity to the LORD? Thirdly, are we obedient to what we know to do in serving our LORD JESUS right now where HE has placed us? The parable strongly suggests that one of the churches greatest temptations throughout history will be to not know what we could know about what the LORD is up to. Knowing everything about HIS plan will not be required of us. But wanting to know everything HE would show us (sensitivity, being ready, being alert, being obedient) will be required of us! Beloved of GOD, with every passing day of our lives, this parable takes on greater life and relevancy. BE READY!!!!

In today's message, we further contemplate and celebrate the LORD's gifts to us in the wonder of the LORD's supper. We also discover that the LORD's understanding of math is higher than ours as you may see from the sermon title. I will explain.....
