

Next Sunday, February 7, is **Souper Bowl Sunday**. The Youth will be collecting funds to benefit **God's Helping Hands**.


**Lunch Bunch** will meet next Sunday, February 7, immediately following the service. Everyone is invited to bring a covered dish and join this informal time of fellowship.
