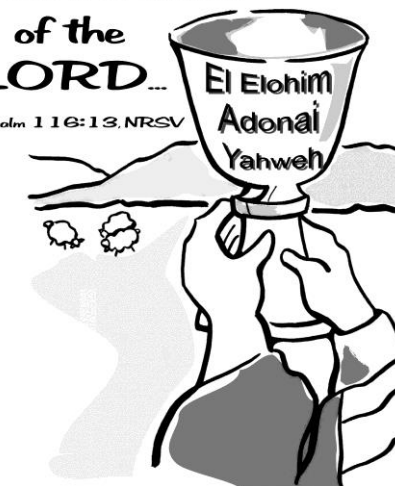

The **Finance Team** will meet on **Wednesday, July 12, at 6 p.m.**

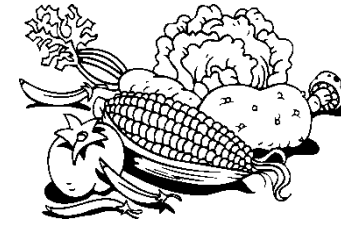


## New Facebook Page for Trinity United Methodist Church
