The Real Jesus of Nazareth February 11 @ 4 p.m. – Parts I & II March 11 @ 4 p.m. – Parts III & IV

In the four-part series <u>*The Real Jesus of Nazareth*</u>, actor Robert Powell will visit the Holy Land, seeking clues to learn more about Jesus. Powell portrayed the Son of God in the 1977 miniseries, Jesus of Nazareth. The original series featured a cast of blockbuster stars, including Sir Laurence Olivier and James Earl Jones. The series has become an Easter and Christmas television tradition for many, and is celebrating its 40th anniversary this year.

The Real Jesus of Nazareth will draw parallels between the scripted depiction of the biblical story and real history, breaking down the life of Jesus and the world he lived in.
