The Real Jesus of Nazareth March 11 @ 4 p.m. - Parts III & IV

Parts III and IV of *The Real Jesus of Nazareth* will be shown on Sunday, March 11, at 4 p.m. *The Real Jesus of Nazareth* draws parallels between the scripted depiction of the biblical story in the 1977 miniseries Jesus of Nazareth and real history, breaking down the life of Jesus and the world he lived in.
