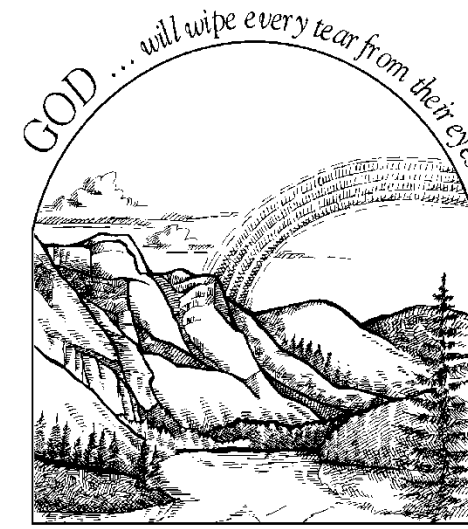

Wednesdays at 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.

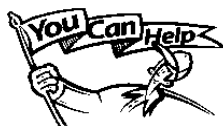
