

To help with your planning should you decide to adopt a family, December the 19th is a half day and some parents begin their Christmas break a bit early so having your family's gifts to the school by Friday, December 14, is advisable.

Because the need is great at Saluda River this year and because of the two opportunities to give, this will be the focus of our outreach for Christmas. On behalf of the Outreach Committee and the UMW, thank you for your generosity in sharing with those less fortunate among us.
