Aldersgate Special Needs Sunday Sunday, August 11

Aldersgate Special Needs Ministry was born at the 2003 South Carolina Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church and provides homes for adults with developmental disabilities. Today, Aldersgate operates three homes for adults with special needs. The homes provide life skills training, recreational experiences and connections to worshipping communities. Adults with special needs are among the most underserved people in South Carolina and the nation. The need for their care continues to grow. The South Carolina Annual Conference gives support by designating an Aldersgate Special Needs Ministry offering to be taken each year on the second Sunday in August, or an alternate Sunday chosen by each church. They are not an apportioned item in the Annual Conference budget.
