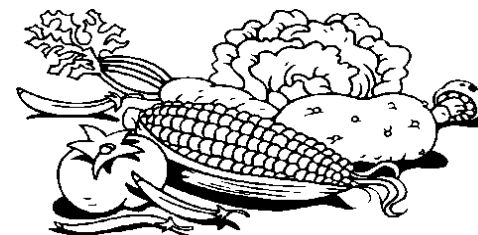
West Columbia Riverwalk Park
