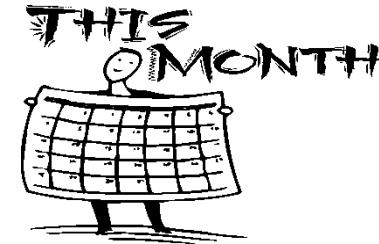


### UMW News
