Celebrate every day the gift of Christ, and when we do get into the height of the Christmas season, then that celebration is all the more blessed.

When I was a child my father would sometimes say to the children "it's your birthday every month!", referring to how often we received more than we deserved around the year. Well, let's make it JESUS' birthday celebration around the year giving the LORD thanks for His gift of Christ. After All, Jesus gives us the gift of himself over and over throughout the year! So enjoy your Christmas in December and January and

February and March. May the fullness of all the plans of the FATHER be yours in CHRIST this Christmas season! Amen!
