### A Biblical Perspective on the Middle East Crisis

In the next few months my GLIA newsletter article will address the Middle East Crises and why this situation should not only concern us as Christians but should also awaken us to the deeper implications of what this means to the entire world. The current fighting between Israel and Hamas is not just about the Gaza strip as some Americans and other global citizens may presume. No, the problem is bigger than will ever be resolved by any human intervention. This subject matter and problem can be very intimidating to the casual observer who doesn't take seriously what is at stake in the Middle East. There is no way any of us can read a dozen articles or less about these issues and know everything possible or needed to be permanently up to date on the crises. That said, I will attempt to give a brief overview about what is happening over there and how and why it will eventually effect us over here in America. If you believe the scriptures address the state of present Israel and address world-wide issues that culminate in the return of CHRIST to earth then I would suggest you read the 2nd Psalm as one of many scripture texts that begin to help us see the reasons for the present Middle East conflict. I take the scriptures seriously in what is stated within the canon about the nation of Israel being the major center piece of GOD's work in the expression of Judeo-Christian ethics and intention. That said, let's begin to look at this overwhelming issue the world is watching in the Middle East.

Since 9/11, America has become painfully aware that there are an endless number of fanatical, Islamic, fascist groups that hate us for the two things we treasure most; our citizenship in heaven and our citizenship as Americans. Paul Marshall, a Senior Fellow at The Center for Religious Freedom in Washington, D.C. said that there is a hate list. First and foremost on the list is Israel. In fact, the official name of Al Qaeda is the "World Islamic Front for Holy War against Jews and Crusaders." During the Middle Ages, terrible things, atrocities, were committed in the name of Jesus Christ. The perpetrators called themselves "Crusaders." So the Islamic mind has associated Christianity with medieval Crusaders. More recently, the United States has been hated because of our support for Israel. We are seen as Israel's bodyguard.

Now to get a better understanding of what is going on in the Middle East, we need to know the root cause of the problem. The problem with all Middle East peacemaking is that it doesn't really address the real issue. Over the past few days we have heard the Hamas organization say, "We've done

nothing wrong, we are the victims of Israeli brutality. Israel responds with "Hezbollah kidnapped our soldiers and Hamas hides behind children and families in their homes." And so it goes—back and forth, just like when we were children and you would call out to your mother, "Johnny hit me, make him stop." Then Johnny would defend himself by claiming, "He hit me first." Well the question to be answered is not so much "Who hit who first?" but "why can't you two children get along with one another?". The same question is necessary regarding the Middle East crises. Why can't Israel and its surrounding neighbors get along?

I have copies of a book that was written to help answer that question called "Your People Shall Be My People". It is written to enable American Christians to better understand the complexities of the Middle East crises. It was recommended to me by Messianic believers some years ago. I will give you a copy of the book if you would like to read it. Right now, I strongly suggest we all pray for the peace of Jerusalem and Israel's surrounding neighbors. I'll continue this article next month.
