We had no idea the extent of their needs until we met them for the first time on Tuesday when we were delivering fruit baskets. I wanted to find the apartment so I could deliver the gifts I had bought for the kids (which was clothes and 1 gift card apiece).

In addition to all of the above, fruit baskets were prepared and delivered to our known shut-ins, and a few extra baskets were prepared and delivered by differing ones of you who knew of someone that needed Jesus' love shared with them.

These are only a few of the many ways we are already helping those who God brings to our attention that are in need of our sharing His love with them.

I thank God for all that each of you do to reach out to help others in some way. I know I did not even scratch the surface of all the things many of you are doing. You are all doing such a great job. Please keep up the great work and give yourself a pat on the back. It seems like at least every month I am learning about something one of you is doing for the kingdom of God.

You all make it so refreshing and awesome to be serving alongside of you. Praise be to God for all the things that you all do for His Glory.
