

Because in January, the Reaching New People emphasis was incorporated into the new Vitality Team! Reaching New People was a program sponsored by the Conference designed to plant the seeds for churches who were declining or dying. We spent a lot of time last year educating our congregation and council on the principles of the program.

So many of the principles focused on the mission focus of the church so it seemed that what we had called the witness team in the past did that. In addition, some of the functions of the previous vital ministries team were a natural fit for the things that the Vitality Team needed to be involved with.

The **Primary Task** of the Vitality Team is to ensure that Trinity reaches out to people in the community with the good news of Jesus Christ and receives them into its care so that these people may develop a relationship with God and live as Christian disciples.
